## **INSTRUCTIONAL DELIVERY**

In a Gifted Resource Room, students are encouraged to reach their full potential as both students and members of society by participating in units that target several areas:

- Cognitive education academic units that allow students to explore topics not covered in the regular curriculum while enhancing and expanding students' mastery of specific grade level expectations
- Affective education self-knowledge and life skills
- Critical and creative thinking skills often involving application of these skills to content knowledge gained in academic units
- Problem solving mathematical, spatial, practical, social
- Communication skills oral and written

The district provides the following services for students in gifted program:

- Kindergarten <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> day per week in a resource room, beginning second semester
- Grades 1-6 1 full day per week in a resource room at Inman Intermediate
- Grade 7 1 class period per day day, incorporated into the social studies curriculum
- Grade 8 1 class period per day when chosen as an elective
- Grade 9 Enrollment in a STAR class for identified gifted students that meet 4 days per week with a Resource Teacher
- Grades 9-12 Enrollment in an elective in-depth Independent Study Program or access to online courses.
